the book of lamentations is one of the most vivid representations of grief and trauma in the hebrew bible written in the wake of the fall of jerusalem to the babylonian empire it is comprised of five poems of twenty two stanzas each in a manner of tight formal unity unparalleled by any other work in the scriptures in this volume widely respected old testament scholar john goldingay analyzes these and other aspects of lamentations while keeping a constant eye on the book s meaning and use as christian scripture after a thorough introduction that explores matters of background composition and theology goldingay provides an original translation of the book from the masoretic text along with verse by verse commentary

the foundation for all study of biblical law is the assumption that the covenant code is the oldest legal code in the hebrew bible and that all other laws are revisions of that code this book sets forth the radical hypothesis that those laws in the covenant code that are similar to deuteronomy and the holiness code are in fact later than both of these and therefore can t be taken as the foundation of hebrew law

in this work karel van der toorn explores the social setting the intellectual milieu and the historical context of the beliefs and practices reflected in the hebrew bible while fully recognizing the unique character of early israelite religion the author challenges the notion of its incomparability beliefs are anchored in culture rituals have societal significance god has a history by shifting the focus to the context the essays gathered here yield a deeper understanding of israelite religion and the origins of the bible

in the god of israel in history and tradition michael stahl provides a foundational study of the formulaic title god of israel elohe yisra el in the hebrew bible employing critical theory on social power and identity and through close literary and historical analysis dr stahl shows how the epithet god of israel evolved to serve different social and political agendas throughout the course of ancient israel and judah s histories reaching beyond the field of biblical studies dr stahl s treatment of the historical and ideological significances of the title god of israel in the hebrew bible offers a fruitful case study into the larger issue of the ways in which religion may shape and be shaped by social and political structures
