in may 1956 aged just 24 colin wilson achieved success and overnight fame with his philosophical study of alienation and transcendence in modern literature and thought the outsider fifty four years on and never out of print in english the book is still widely read and discussed having been translated into over thirty languages in a remarkably prolific career wilson a true polymath has since written over 170 titles novels plays and non fiction on a variety of subjects this volume brings together twenty essays by scholars of colin wilson s work worldwide and is published in his honour to mark the author s 80th birthday each contributor has provided an essay on their favourite wilson book or the one they consider to be the most significant the result is a varied and stimulating assessment of wilson s writings on philosophy psychology literature criminology and the occult with critical appraisals of four of his most thought provoking novels altogether a fitting tribute to a writer

what were the achievements of the angry writers who emerged in the fifties historically they gave birth to the satire movement of the 1960s beyond the fringe that was the week that was and private eye their satire and irreverence aroused enthusiasm in man and a new anti establishment mood developed from look back in anger and the outsider all literary movements acquire enemies but the angry young men of the 1950s accumulated more than most why wilson takes us on a journey back to this era and reveals fascinating and sometimes disturbing stories from the greats including john osborne kingsley amis kenneth tynan and john braine to name but a few at all events the story of that period makes a marvellously lively tale which most importantly was recorded by someone who was actually there

blending existential and occult thought a highly acclaimed philosopher explains how we can find profound meaning and joy by inducing states of extreme awareness and emotion throughout history there have been references and examples in literature art and philosophy of an increased awareness of life while under the influence of extreme emotions these have become known as peak experiences soon after colin wilson became aware of this phenomenon in the 1960s he wondered about its history and how its power could be harnessed and began a forty year investigation in super consciousness we see how such luminaries as yeats blake sartre nietzsche and robert graves were affected by peak experiences and how it has long been noted that we are least insightful when we are at our lowest ebb by looking in detail through the different areas where this phenomenon has occurred and by offering anecdotes and examples of how many people in history as well as himself were affected wilson reveals a pattern of insight with emotions he

when the archive of the english philosopher and polymath colin wilson 1931 2013 was officially opened at the university of nottingham uk in the summer of 2011 it was agreed among those present that a conference should be held there to discuss his work in july 2016 the first international colin wilson conference was staged with the proceedings being published a year later the success of that conference inevitably meant that a second was arranged and held two years later in july 2018 this volume which will be of interest to scholars and fans of wilson s work in addition to students of philosophy and consciousness studies contains the transcripts of the papers presented on july 6 2018 day one of that second conference experts scholars and fans from around the globe gathered to hear and present papers on a variety of wilson related topics ranging from existentialism to the occult from robert musil to classical music and from transpersonal psychology to transcendental evolution

human beings have always been cruel savage and murderous is that all about to change human history can be seen as a catalog of coldhearted murders mindless blood feuds appalling massacres and devastating wars creatively and intellectually there is no other species that has ever come close to equaling humanity s achievements but neither is any other species as suicidally prone to internecine conflict we are the only species on the planet whose ingrained habit of conflict and perpetual warfare constitutes the chief threat to our own survival in an end to murder the wilsons assess whether human beings are in reality as cruel and violent as is generally believed the book explores the possibility that humankind is on the verge of a fundamental change that we are about to become truly civilized covering a wide reaching history of violence from the first hominids to the twenty first century the book touches on key moments of change while also indicating where things have not changed since the stone age it follows the history of violence from fifteenth century baron gilles de rais bluebeard the first known and possibly most prolific serial killer in history to
